Drawings for Post Numbers in the Kentucky Derby

Winner Breakdown:

- Win - Amount Winning Horse wins in Free Slot Play
- Place - Amount Place Horse wins in Free Slot Play
- Show - Amount Show Horse wins in Free Slot Play

How to Earn Entries:

- Raffle in Kentucky Derby Seminar
- Earn one (1) entry for every \$20 wagered in Race
- Maximum 10 tickets per window visit
- Entries must be earned on day of drawing

Rules:

1. Participants must have a Rampart Rewards card and be at least 21 years of age to participate. Guests without a card can sign up at the Rampart Rewards Club for free.
2. Drawings will take place at the designated area (see Race & Sports Book for details.)
3. Customer must be present to win.
