Cash Drawings Friday & Saturday Nights at 6:15 pm & 8:15 pm
Start Earning Entries March 30 at 3:00 am.

Winner Breakdown: 10 winners at each drawing at 6:15 pm & 8:15 pm. 40 winners each weekend.

Prize Breakdown:

83-\$250 Cash | 90-\$400 Cash | 63-\$500 Cash | 7-\$750 Cash | 6-\$1,000 Cash | 1-\$10,000 Cash

How to Earn Entries:

- Guests earn one kiosk entry for every 100 points earned on Slots
- Customers earn one kiosk entry for every one-hour of play at \$10 avg or equivalent on Table Games
- Customers earn 10X entries from Monday-Thursday each week
- Bonus entries will be awarded through mailers and kiosk promotions
- Drawing entries will be valid for the entire month
- Participants must swipe-in after 3 pm on Friday and Saturday to be eligible for that night's drawings

Rules:

1. Participants must have a Rampart Rewards Club card and be at least 21 years of age to participate. Guests without a card can sign up at the Rampart Rewards Club for Free.
2. Participants must swipe-in after 3 pm and before any of the drawings on Friday and Saturday. (Only one swipe required per drawing day. No points required to swipe in entries.)
3. Participants who check into the drawing without entries are not eligible to win.
4. Drawings will take place at the designated area (see Rampart Rewards Club for details).
5. Customer must be present to win. Guests have three minutes to claim their prize.
6. Starting March 30 patrons will start earning entries into the drawing for every 100 base points earned each day playing slots and table games.
7. Automated drawing entries are non-transferable.
8. At each Friday and Saturday drawing at 6:15 pm and 8:15 pm, ten winners will be drawn. Each winner will draw from the drum to choose an envelope with their prize amount inside.
9. The Prize Drum will be reset after each drawing.
10. All winners must show their Rampart Rewards Club card and have valid identification to be verified.
11. Guest may choose cash, free slot play or promotional chips for amounts under \$1,000.
12. Participants may only be drawn once per weekend.
13. The drawing barrel will be emptied after the last drawing of the month on April 27 at 8:15 pm. All player drawing entries will re-set at zero at this time.
