Drawings: December 6, 7, 13, 14, 20, 21, 27 & 28, 2019

Promotion Period: 3 am November 30, 2019 thru 10 pm December 28, 2019

Players earn 2X entries Sunday - Friday.

Winner Breakdown:

- Five (5) winners at each drawing at 9 pm & 10 pm. 20 winners each weekend.

Prize Breakdown:

- 14 - \$250 in Promo Chips with "Play Again" bonus
- 15 - \$250 in Promo Chips
- 16 - \$300 in Promo Chips
- 22 - \$400 in Promo Chips
- 22 - \$750 Cash
- 10 - \$1,000 Cash
- 1 - \$5,000 Cash

How to Earn Entries:

- Customers earn one kiosk entry for every one-hour of play at \$10 average or equivalent on Table Games
- Customers earn 2X entries from Sunday-Friday each week
- Bonus entries will be awarded through mailers and kiosk promotions

Rules:

1. Participants must have a Rampart Rewards Club card and be at least 21 years of age to participate. Guests without a card can sign up at the Rampart Rewards Club for free.
2. Participants must swipe-in between 3:00 pm and 8:55 pm on Friday and Saturday for the 9:00 pm drawing or between 9:10 pm and 9:55 pm for the 10:00 pm drawing. (Only one swipe required per day. No points required to swipe in entries.)
3. Customers who check into the drawing without entries are not eligible to win.
4. Drawings will take place at the designated area (see Rampart Rewards Club for details).
5. Customer must be present to win. Guests have three minutes to claim their prize.
6. Starting November 30 at 3:00 am patrons will start earning entries into the drawing for every one hour of play at \$10 average bet or equivalent on table games.
7. Automated drawing entries are non-transferable.
8. Drawings will be held December 6, 7, 13, 14, 20, 21, 27 & 28, 2019.
9. At each Friday and Saturday drawing at 9 pm and 10 pm, five (5) winners will be drawn. Each winner will draw from the drum to choose an envelope with their prize amount inside.
10. Customers can choose their prize in cash, free slot play, promotional chips, or points.
11. The Prize Drum will be reset after each drawing.
12. Although this promotion is called the \$50,000 Unwrap the Cash, the actual amount of prize consideration awarded may exceed, equal, or be less than \$50,000, and the actual amount of prize consideration awarded will be determined randomly by the cumulative outcome of each winning contestant's draw from the prize drum.
13. All winners must show their Rampart Rewards Club card and have valid identification to be verified.

15. The drawing barrel will be emptied after the 10 pm Saturday Drawing each week. All player drawing entries will re-set at zero at this time.
