### How to Earn Drawing Entries:

1 entry per:

- Customers earn 1 kiosk entry for every 1 hour of play at \$10 average or equivalent on Table Games
- Customers earn 2X entries from Sunday-Friday each week
- Bonus entries will be awarded through mailers and kiosk promotions

- Two (2) ..... \$500 promo chips

### Rules:
