Cash Drawings Friday & Saturday Nights
at 6:15 pm & 8:15 pm

Start Earning Entries December 26 at 3 am

Winner Breakdown: 10 winners at each drawing at 6:15 pm & 8:15 pm. 20 winners each night.

Prize Breakdown:

100–\$250 Cash | 49–\$350 Cash | 15–\$400 Cash | 7–\$500 Cash | 3–\$1,000 Cash | 1–\$5,000 Cash

How to Earn Entries:

- Guests earn one kiosk entry for every 100 points earned on Slots or Bingo
- Customers earn one kiosk entry for every one hour of play at \$10 average or equivalent on Table Games
- Customers earn 10X entries from Monday-Thursday each week
- Bonus entries will be awarded through mailers and kiosk promotions
- Drawing entries will be valid for the entire month
- Participants must swipe-in after 3 pm on Friday & Saturday to be eligible for that night's drawings

Rules:

2. Participants must swipe-in after 3 pm and before any of the drawings on Friday & Saturday. (Only one swipe required per drawing day. No points required to swipe in entries.)
3. Participants who check into the drawing without entries are not eligible to win.
4. Drawings will take place at the designated area (see Rampart Rewards Club for details).
5. Customer must be present to win. Guests have three minutes to claim their prize.
6. Prizes can be awarded as Free Slot Play, Cash or Promotional Chips.
7. Starting December 26, at 3 am, patrons will start earning entries into the drawing for every 100 base points earned each day playing slots or Bingo and for every one hour of play at \$10 average or equivalent on table games.
8. Automated drawing entries are non-transferable.
9. At each Friday & Saturday drawing at 6:15 pm and 8:15 pm, ten winners will be drawn. There will be 100 envelopes in the drum. The player will draw three envelopes to claim their prize. The player receives the cumulative prize of the tickets. The envelopes drawn will be placed back in the drum before the next drawing.
